We have been closely watching the expanding global disruption caused by the spread of COVID-19, and it is now clear that we must rescind our approval for this program as previously planned. With this rapidly evolving situation and updated travel advisories, we have decided to postpone all of the Summer 2020 GO programs with travel starting in May.

If your program provider is able to accommodate travel/programming after May (June-August), we may be able to reconsider your approval status on April 15. We hope by then we will have a better idea of the impacts of COVID-19 for travel in June and July. Your preparations course will be modified to accommodate a shortened schedule if we are able to travel - <u>your OFFP-course will not start next week</u>. **Please let us know if this is an option for your program provider.** 

We are as disappointed about this situation as we are sure that many of you are - and we have made this difficult decision on the basis of what we feel is in the best interest of your personal health and wellbeing.

If your travel is not able to be postponed by the provider, we will remove the OFFP-Preparations for GO course from your schedule.

As completion of the GO program is part of your academic requirements here at Susquehanna, our primary goal is to keep you on track for graduation while maintaining your health and safety.

We know you'll have many questions and concerns and we continue to be here to help you as we all respond to this unfortunate situation.
