We have been closely watching the expanding global disruption caused by the spread of COVID-19, and it is now clear that we are unable to offer this program in May as previously planned. With this rapidly evolving situation and updated travel advisories, we have decided to postpone all of the Summer 2020 GO Short programs with travel starting in May.

We are as disappointed about this situation as we are sure that many of you are - and we have made this difficult decision on the basis of what we feel is in the best interest of your personal health and wellbeing.
